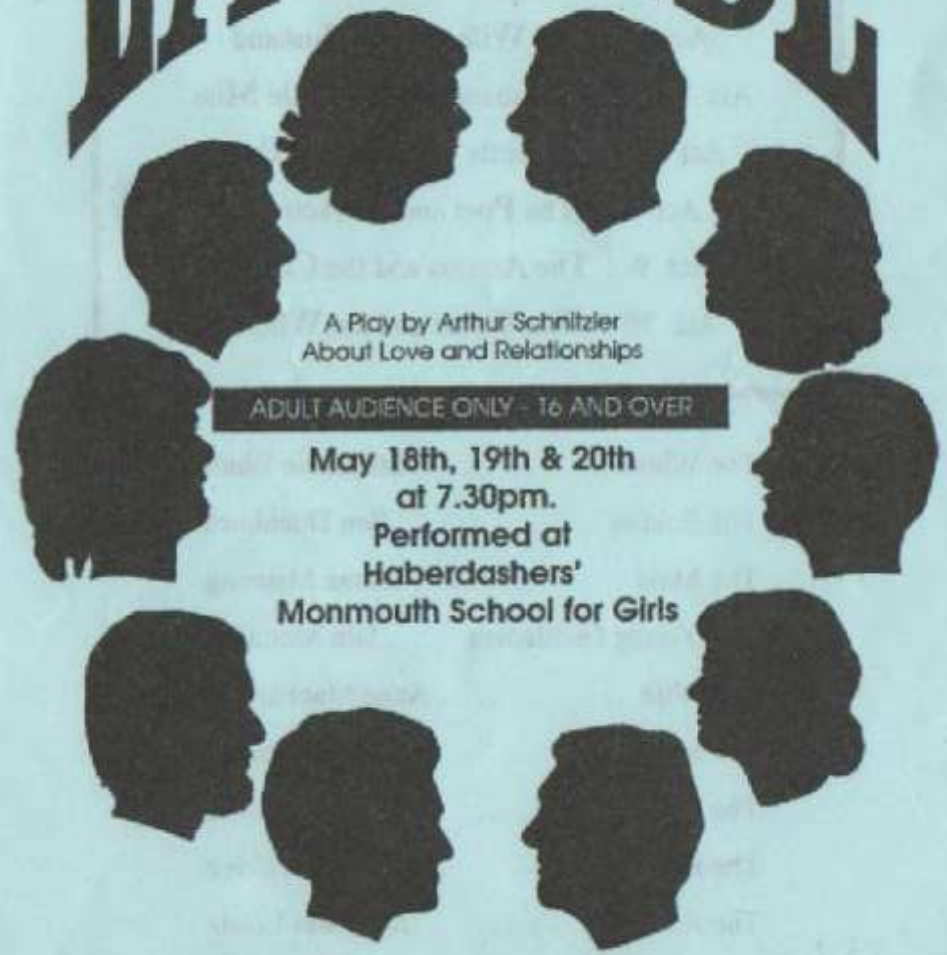
So please sit back and, perhaps, associate some of your own experiences of love and relationships with the actors themselves.
