### *Notes from the Director*

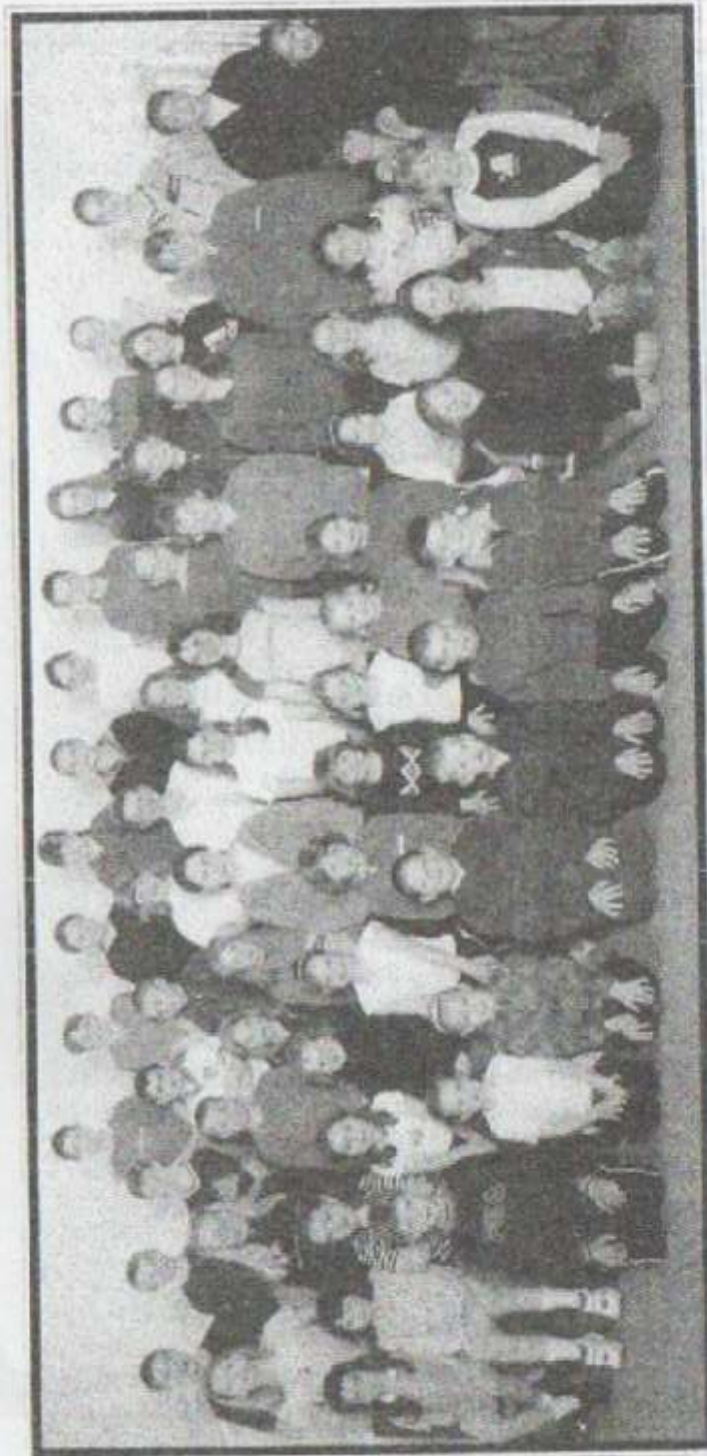

## Ty Hafan—A Place for Living

Located in Sully in the Vale of Glamorgan, **Ty Hafan** opened in January 1999. It is a purpose built and beautiful 'home from home' building designed for maximum comfort and care with 10 children's bedrooms and 8 family rooms overlooking the sea. There are gardens and play areas with ample provision for play and recreation as well as space for peace and reflection.

**Specialist facilities** include multi-sensory room, jacuzzi, music room, activity rooms, chapel, with its open style and numerous lounges creating a relaxed and informal atmosphere.

**Ty Hafan provides** a safe haven with a team committed to child and family centred care and experienced in its delivery.

**The team** consists of Registered Sick Children's Nurses, Registered Nurses, Nursery Nurses, Care Assistants, Play Staff, Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapists, as well as their own Chaplain. They are supported by General Medical Practitioners on call at all times. The cooks and housekeeping staff provide the finishing homely touches. Link-workers from the Care Team liaise with children and their families and other professionals involved in their care whilst at home. The Family Support Worker offers specialist assistance through life and bereavement, so **Ty Hafan** is always there when needed.

**Ty Hafan** has been built and equipped by public donations and will cost £1 million each year to maintain the service which is completely free to all the families - your help is needed to continue this service for children who have a life-limiting illness and their families.

**Ty Hafan is Wales' only children's hospice and your support is necessary to make it flourish and grow.**
